Trexler Game Preserve North Range

## Work To Be Completed:

Part 1 - Berm Building  
Part 2 - Brush Clearing

## Project Description:

Part 1 - Broken Arrow trail was extended in the spring and the final part of the extension that exists in the woods just prior to where the trail switches direction and begins to descend needs improvements to increase rider safety and experience.

Part 2 - Broken Arrow trail has a corridor of weeds and brush. That is making the trail very narrow and with the steep incline, the brush can fall and hang low in the path of trail users.

## Need:

Part 1 - Goal is build a right-hand berm that will keep riders off of the breaks while decreasing elevation in the turn.

Part 2 - Goal is to clear the brush of up to 5 year's worth of growth to meet trail standards for right of way. Increased visibility should allow for user experience.

Straw and other natural fibers from the surrounding area.

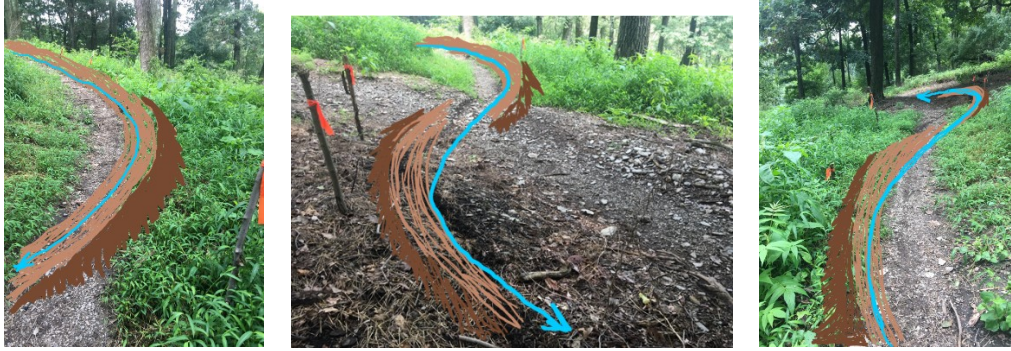
